

School rules

You must:

- be in the classroom when the lesson starts
- send a message to the school if you are going to be absent
- bring books, PC and other things you need
- be active in classes
- tidy up after yourself
- be respectful to others – also on the Internet
- do as the teachers and other school staff say

You cannot:

- break school property
- bully or exclude others
- use violence or threaten anyone
- use offensive language
- cheat
- take pictures or videos of others without their permission
- use, buy, sell or possess tobacco, drugs or alcohol
- bring dangerous items or weapons
- use clothing that covers your face

If you do not follow the rules, the school can:

- give you a reprimand
- give you a written warning
- send a message to your parents
- give you assignments to do, before or after school
- give you a lower grade for orderliness or conduct
- send you home
- move you to another school
